Visitors to the library have access to an on-staff health sciences librarian that can help research a specific condition, disease or injury through a variety of resources:

- **MedlinePlus** - a premier health information database by the National Library of Medicine that covers conditions, diseases, injuries, medication information and much more.
- **Online library catalog** - find books, DVDs and journals available for check-out.
- **Internet searches** - access information from other reliable health organizations and online resources that the library subscribes to - some of the same resources your physician uses.

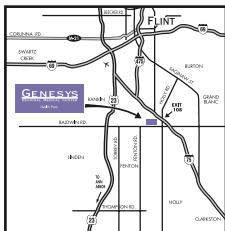
