

Outpatient Breastfeeding Clinics...helping moms breastfeed their babies

Sometimes, new moms need guidance as they begin breastfeeding their babies. Sometimes, problems arise after breastfeeding has been established. Our four Outpatient Breastfeeding Clinics address the needs of the mother and infant. The clinics are the first physician-led breastfeeding clinics in Michigan.

Each of the sites is staffed by physicians and lactation consultants. Mothers can self refer or be referred by their physician.

The clinics provide support to mothers and infants who are experiencing breastfeeding difficulty, such as;

- Poor latch
- Insufficient milk supply
- Engorgement
- Painful breastfeeding
- Poor weight gain
- Prematurity
- Cleft palate, Downs Syndrome, and Tongue-tie
