Being an Internal Medicine PGY I – your schedule was determined by the AOA and your Program Director – Susan Enright, D.O. Your schedule will consist of:

1-house nights, 4-General Medicine, 1-EM, 1- MICU, 1-Anes, 1-cardiology, 1-(2wks) G.Surgery/(2 wks) SICU, 1- Endocrinology, 1-Womans Health and 1-Elective rotation. The elective is a choice of any rotation offered at Genesys (please make a 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> choice in case the 1<sup>st</sup> choice is not available) or should you decide to go to another institution you should set this up with the institution of choice and then complete paperwork in the Genesys Medical Education office. **PGY I Scheduling Choices**

**for MSP, SSP, Selective**

Choices are:

**MSP (medicine sub-specialty)** Cardiology, Endocrinology, Geriatrics, GI, Hematology, Infectious Disease, Nephrology, Neurology, Pulmonary, and Rheumatology

**SSP (Surgery sub-specialty)** Anesthesia , General Surgery, Gyn-Surgery, Neuro-Surgery, Obstetrics, Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, and Urology, Cardiovascular & Thoracic Surgery

**Selective** – Emergency Medicine, Family Medicine, OMM, Pathology, Pediatrics, Radiology, Units and any MSP or SSP.

**Elective** – This is your choice. This rotation can be done either in house or out. If you would like to go outside to complete it, you need to contact the other institution ASAP to set it up. Once you get the okay, you must complete the “Out Rotation” form located in Med. Ed. Once completed you must turn it in to your program coordinator/assistant to get necessary signatures. They will then gather the items needed from your file (license, ACLS, BLS, etc.) and send them out. This should be done within your first rotation, since rotations get booked up fast.
