

RN Reward\$ Scholarship Information

Scholarships have been established through a joint, cooperative effort between Genesys Health System and the Teamsters Local 332. This partnership strives to assist Genesys Health System to continue to build excellence in our nursing team.

There are three scholarships available:

- **RN Bridge Scholarships** of \$2500 per semester are available to any Genesys Health System employee pursuing an associate or bachelor degree in Nursing.
- **RN to BSN Scholarships** of \$1200 per semester are available to any Genesys Regional Medical Center staff RN pursuing a bachelor's degree in nursing.
- **BSN Bridge Scholarships** of \$2500 per semester are available to any nursing student seeking a bachelor degree in nursing.

All 3 scholarships are renewable; however, previous recipients must reapply each semester. Scholarship awards are not to exceed actual costs of tuition & fees during that semester. Scholarship recipients are not eligible to receive Tuition Reimbursement in the same semester.

Eligibility requirements for an **RN Bridge Scholarship** include:

- Current Genesys Health System full time or part time employee
- Registered in an accredited Nursing program
- Completed 12 credit hours with a cumulative 2.8 GPA
- A good work record (no more than 2 written reprimands in the last 12 months, no suspension in the last 18 months, minimum of "Standards Met" on latest performance appraisal)
- Upon completion of your academic program, willing to begin working at GRMC as a GN within 30 days, schedule NCLEX exam within 60 days and continue working at GRMC as a staff RN for six months (1040 hours) for each semester scholarship award.

Eligibility requirements for an **RN to BSN Bridge Scholarship** include:

- A current Genesys Regional Medical Center full time or part time RN
- Currently enrolled in an accredited BSN program with a cumulative 2.8 GPA
- A good work record (no more than 2 written reprimands in the last 12 months, no suspension in the last 18 months, minimum of "Standards Met" on latest performance appraisal)
- Upon completion of your academic program, willing to continue working at GRMC as a staff RN for six months (1040 hours) for each semester scholarship award.

Eligibility requirements for a **BSN Bridge Scholarship** include:

- Currently a junior or senior in an accredited BSN program with a cumulative 2.8 GPA
- Upon completion of your academic program, willing to begin working at Genesys Regional Medical Center (GRMC) as a staff RN within 30 days, schedule the NCLEX within 60 days and continue working at GRMC for 1 year (2080 hours) for each semester award.

Scholarship applications are accepted three times a year. The deadline dates are as follows:

April 8th, (Spring/Summer semesters); **August 1st**, (Fall semester); **December 1st** (Winter semester).
